ORDINANCE NO. 2018-09-06 (B)

**ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS,
DECLARING THE ELECTION OF AMY PATILLO TO THE OFFICE OF
ALDERPERSON, PROVIDING FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE TEXAS
ELECTION CODE REGARDING NOTICE OF SUCH DECLARATION;
AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City Council ordered a special election to be held on November 6, 2018 to fill the unexpired term of the offices of Alderperson resulting from a resignation;

WHEREAS, both the deadline for candidates to file an application to appear on the ballot and the deadline to file a declaration to appear as a write-in candidate in such election have passed;

WHEREAS, no one has filed a declaration to appear as a write-in candidate, and only Amy Patillo has filed an application to appear on the ballot for the vacancy to be filled in the unexpired office of Alderperson without having later timely and properly withdrawn from the election in conformance with Texas Election Code Chapter 145;

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has delivered a certification to the City Council pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 2.052 certifying that Amy Patillo is unopposed in filling the vacancy in the unexpired office of Alderperson;

WHEREAS, Texas Election Code Section 2.053 provides that the City Council may declare an unopposed candidate elected to the office; and

WHEREAS, by separate certification to the City Council pursuant to Section 2.052 certifying the unopposed status of candidates to fill expiring terms in the offices of Mayor and of two Alderpersons in a general election to be held concurrently with such special election, the City Council is declaring the election of such unopposed candidates, so that no election will be necessary or will be held on November 6, 2018,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLINGWOOD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. All of the above premises are hereby found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council, and are hereby approved and incorporated into the body of this Ordinance as if copied in their entirety.


SECTION 2. Amy Patillo is hereby declared elected to the unexpired office of Alderperson, to assume such office in the time and manner as though elected at the special election on November 6, 2018. The special election to fill the vacancy in the unexpired office of Alderperson previously ordered for November 6, 2018 shall not be held.

SECTION 3. In conformance with Texas Election Code Section 2.053, a copy of this ordinance shall be posted on election day at each polling place in the November 6, 2018 special election.

SECTION 4. Severability. Should any part, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance be determined to be unlawful, void or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance shall not be adversely affected. No portion of this Ordinance shall fail or become inoperative by reason of the invalidity of any other part. All provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance is effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
